

Procedure for the Cleaning and Disinfection of Foot Thrones

Drain, clean, and disinfect the throne **after each client** by:

- filling bath with warm, soapy water,
- brushing and scrubbing all surfaces
- draining and rinsing the unit, and
- disinfecting using manufacturer's protocol or in the absence of instructions:

1:100 solution of household chlorine bleach and water,
or

AHP (accelerated hydrogen peroxide) used in accordance with product specifications.

Circulate the disinfectant through the throne for at least ten minutes. Clean foot throne screens **at least daily** to remove debris and assist in preventing biofilm build-up.

To prepare **1:100** solution of household chlorine bleach and water:

1. Begin by making a **1:10** bleach solution by adding one volume of household chlorine bleach (e.g. 1 litre) to 9 volumes of clean water (e.g. 9 litres).
2. Prepare the **1:100** bleach solution by adding one volume of **1:10** bleach solution (e.g. 1 litre) to 9 volumes of clean water (e.g. 9 litres).

Note: 1:100 bleach solution can also be prepared directly from household bleach by adding 1 volume of household bleach to 99 volumes of clean water (e.g. 100 ml of bleach to 9.9 litres of clean water), but making it up from 1:10 bleach solution is much easier!).
